Through the end of March and throughout April, as a church, we are going across the street to change our world for Jesus Christ. In the days ahead you will be hearing about how you can get involved in this year's FBC Loves: 30 Days to Change Your World Campaign. The challenge before you will be:

- To commit to Prayer Walk the streets of Wylie by passing out door hangers inviting the community to send prayer requests via www.prayercanchangethings.com to the church. As a church we will take those prayer requests and spend the next 30 days praying specifically for the hurts and pains our community is experiencing.
- Commit to pray for 3 lost people you know that they will come to know Christ over the next 30 days.
- Commit to Plug-In to the community by being part of our "One Day Projects" and by doing our 8 challenges in this brochure. You will have many opportunities to be the hands and feet of Christ by being a part of many of our outreach events.

30 Days to Change Your World

FAMILY CHALLENGES

Why is it that we have to beg adults to serve, while children are always ready to give? Children seem to be born with a desire to serve others. Even a 2 year old will comfort a crying baby by sharing a toy!

Open children's hearts to others' needs. Here are four key reasons that evangelism is important to children's faith development. Hebrews 13:16 reminds us of the call to serve: "And do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased." Serving is a practical way to show children how God wants us to live out his Word:

- To see that there's more going on in our world besides what we see on the news every day.
- To learn how to pray for others.
- To learn how to give.
- To hear the exciting stories of how God is at work in our world.

Before you begin the 30 Days, take time to know who your neighbors are by filling in "Who Are My Neighbors?" diagram. Spend time throughout the 30 Days praying for those people who live by you and sit by at school and at work.

Week of April 4-10

April 6

Take a walk around your neighborhood with your kids. With younger children, stop every 50 steps and invite the children to look around for: 1. Something to praise God for creating 2. Someone who has a need 3. Something that reminds them of a blessing God has given them.

Allow about 10 seconds for children to look around and 10 seconds to pray before resuming your walk. Take into account your child's attention span. Romans 12:13

April 8

Do something nice for a friend, like buy a coke from Sonic after school or buy them a piece of candy. Let them know this is a practical way to show Christ's love for them. Matthew 22:39

Week of April 11-17

April 13

Administrative Day (Romans 13:1-3) Write a note to your teachers, principles, etc., and ask to do something for them and pray these passages for them- Ephesians 1:17-20, Philip.1:8 -11, 1 Thess. 3:12-13, Ephesians 3:16-20, Colossians, 1:9 – 11, 2 Thess. 1:1-11.

April 15

Write a Note day. Write a note or color a homemade card to someone that needs encouragement (James 2:1-3). When you take it to them or mail it, take time to pray over the card and for that person.

Week of April 18-24

April 20

YOUTH : Wash a Windshield Day (Matt. 22:39) Meet at Exxon Gas Station (544 & 78 from 4:30 – 5:30).

Letting Go (Matthew 25:36a, 40) Clean out closet, get nice outfit and drop off at Children's Advocacy Center for another child to use.

April 22

Cookies for Neighbors (Matt. 20:26-28) Make a batch of cookies and as a family, deliver to your neighbors. Let them know this is a way you can show them God's love in a practical way.

Week of April 25-May 1

April 27

YOUTH – Mow Lawn Day (Matt 25:35-40) Use your lawn mower, gas and weed-eater and mow your neighbor's yard (ask permission first!).

Hand our water bottles at the nearest neighborhood park (Matthew 25:35-40) . This will cost you some money and time, but it will be worth it. Serving others always costs us. Tell them, "This is just to show you God loves you in tangible way."

April 29

Media Fast Day – (Psalms 101: 2-3) Be Media Free for 24 hours – no TV, videos, newspaper, internet, radio, cd's, dvd's, movies or phones.

The time you would have spent with the media, spend reading your Bible and praying.
